From the Pastor's Desk

THE LORD RAISES THOSE WHO ARE BOW DOWN

GREETINGS TO YOU ALL IN THE NAME OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST!

This Sunday's message is based on the topic Lord raises those who are down drawn from **Psalm 146:8, which declares: "The Lord lifts up those who are bowed down."** Life often weighs us down. A person may be bowed low by sickness, burdens, or emotional pain—just as a wounded animal, struck by a hunter, cannot rise again without help. In the same way, we, too, need someone to lift us up. But thanks be to God, He is our Helper. As we read in Psalm 146:7-10, it is in God's very nature to raise up the weary, heal the brokenhearted, and restore those crushed in spirit. He not only brings physical healing but also revives us spiritually. These are things no human effort can fully accomplish—only God Himself can truly restore us. Let us be ready to receive hope, healing, and strength from the One who lifts us up when we can no longer stand.

Raises Those Bowed Down by Belittlement.

As Psalm 113:7 says, "He lifts the poor from the dust and the needy from the ash heap." Many of us have experienced moments where circumstances—or even people—have made us feel small, rejected, or unworthy. But God's promise remains firm: He will lift up those who are bowed down. Consider Leah, a powerful example from Scripture. She endured the pain of not being loved by Jacob—a piercing arrow of not being loved to the soul. Few wounds hurt more deeply than the feeling of being unloved. Yet, despite this rejection, Leah became the mother of Jacob's first son, and through her came Judah, the tribe from which Jesus Himself would descend—God loved and favored Leah. God's love found her, lifted her, and gave her purpose beyond her pain. If you are like Leah today—unseen, unvalued—know this: God sees you and loves you deeply. As John 3:16 reminds us, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life". Through faith in Christ, we become children of God, loved eternally and unconditionally. David is another powerful example. He was overlooked by his own family—seen as too small, too insignificant to be king. But God saw differently. The very one tending sheep in obscurity was chosen by God and anointed by Samuel to rule over Israel. David carried the arrow of not being deserved, yet the Lord lifted him from the sheepfold and made him ruler of a nation. Brothers and sisters, no amount of rejection, belittlement, or feelings of unworthiness can cancel the love God has for you. As Romans assures us, "Nothing can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Let this be your confidence: God lifts up those who are bowed down—and He will lift you, too.

Raises those who are bowed down by their brothers.

Genesis 49:23 says, "With bitterness, archers attacked him; they shot at him with hostility." This verse speaks of Joseph, who was struck by many arrows—arrows of hatred, jealousy, betrayal, slavery, temptation, false accusation, and unjust imprisonment. His own brothers despised him when he shared the dream God had given him. Their envy turned so bitter that they plotted to kill him. Instead, they threw him into a dry pit, and he was later lifted out by the Midianites and sold to the Ishmaelites. What's fascinating is this: the Midianites spirit are known for destroying harvests and fruit—yet God used them as part of Joseph's journey to become fruitful. The very people meant to destroy were used by God to raise Joseph up. This is a reminder to us: God can use those who are against us to fulfill His purpose in us. Joseph endured every hardship with faithfulness. Even in prison, he lifted up God, not himself. In Genesis 41:16, Joseph said, "I cannot do it... but God will give Pharaoh the answer he desires." He laid down his self-importance and exalted God. Some burdens and trials come to break our pride, to put our self to death—so that God can lift us up. Joseph, who was rejected by his own family, was raised to a position second only to Pharaoh. From the pit to the palace, God exalted him. And Joseph didn't return evil for evil. Though he had the power to retaliate, he chose forgiveness. As Genesis 49:22 declares, "Joseph is a fruitful vine." Likewise, we too are called to be fruitful—not just in comfort, but even in the face of those who wound us. Today, if you feel rejected—even by your own family—remember this: God sees, God knows, and God is able to lift you up. But some remain bowed down because

they are still holding onto their own pride or pain. Surrender it. Let Joseph's life inspire us: to stay faithful, to exalt God, and to choose love over revenge. We are not called to hate those who hurt us—we are called to bear fruit even for them.

Raises Those Who Are Bowed Down by Their Enemies.

In Mark 9:19–29, we see Jesus deliver a boy oppressed by an unclean spirit—specifically a mute and deaf spirit. This passage reminds us that God has the power to lift us up, even when we are under attack by such spirits. Let's understand what this means:

- A mute spirit silences your connection with God. It keeps you from praying, praising, giving thanks, or walking in the power and purpose of the Holy Spirit.
- A deaf spirit blocks you from hearing, receiving, and obeying God's Word.

Sadly, even those who are saved can be affected by these spirits—especially the saved. Within our churches, there are those who believe but still struggle to pray, praise, or obey. As Matthew 13:19 warns: "When anyone hears the word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart." This is a spiritual battle, and these spirits bring spiritual tiredness, confusion, and discouragement. Like the man who fell asleep while Paul preached (Acts 20:9), we may spiritually fall—but through divine intervention, we can rise again. Jesus said in Mark 9:29, "This kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."

Victory comes through fasting, prayer, and faith. Just as the boy's father cried out in Mark 9:24, "Lord, I believe—help my unbelief!"—we too must call upon the Lord for mercy and strength. Let's also remember David, who was constantly under attack from his enemies. Yet, as we read in Psalm 18, even in the midst of affliction, hatred, and threats of death, he did not stop calling on the name of the Lord. God heard him and lifted him out of every pit. If today you are struggling to pray...

If you feel spiritually numb... If someone in your family is bound by a mute or deaf spirit... Pray for them. Fast for them. It is our responsibility to intercede. Surround yourself with Godly fellowship, because as Ecclesiastes 4:10 says: "If one falls, the other will lift him up. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, for he has no one to help him up." We need God, His church, and one another to stand strong and rise from every pit.

Conclusion:

Brothers and sisters, if you feel today like you are in a deep pit, with no one to help—know this: No pit is too deep for our God. As Psalm 91:1–6 promises, His protection, love, and deliverance surround those who abide in Him. When the enemy tries to cripple you, fast, pray, and stay steadfast—because the Lord is able and willing to raise you up. Amen

DID YOU KNOW?? SOME FACTS ABOUT MATRIACHS OF ISRAEL

- THE MATRIARCHS, OR IMAHOT (אמהות) IN HEBREW, REFERS TO THE TORAH'S FOUR FOUNDATIONAL WOMEN: **SARAH, REBECCA, RACHEL AND LEAH**. THE TALMUD ANSWERS THAT THE DESIGNATION OF PATRIARCH OR MATRIARCH IS NOT BASED (STRICTLY) ON ANCESTRY BUT ON PROMINENCE. IT WAS THESE FOUR GREAT WOMEN WHO FORMED THE SPIRITUAL BASE UPON WHICH OUR NATION WAS BUILT.
- ABRAHAM AND SARAH WERE THE PARENTS OF ISAAC WHO, WITH REBECCA, PARENTED JACOB. WITH HIS TWO WIVES RACHEL AND LEAH (AND TWO HANDMAIDS, BILHAH AND ZILPAH), JACOB FATHERED 12 SONS AND ONE DAUGHTER, DINAH. THE 12 SONS WOULD GO ON TO FORM THE 12 TRIBES OF ISRAEL.
- THE THREE PATRIARCHS, AS WELL AS SARAH, REBECCA AND LEAH, ARE BELIEVED TO BE BURIED AT THE TOMB OF THE PATRIARCHS IN HEBRON, A CITY IN THE SOUTHERN WEST BANK (A REGION ALSO KNOWN AS JUDEA). THE SITE IS ALSO KNOWN AS THE CAVE OF THE PATRIARCHS OR CAVE OF MACHPELAH
- RACHEL IS THE ONLY ONE OF THE PATRIARCHS AND MATRIARCHS NOT BURIED IN CAVE OF MACHPELAH. RACHEL'S TOMB IS LOCATED OUTSIDE THE CITY OF BETHLEHEM, WHICH IS ABOUT 5.5 MILES FROM THE TOMB OF THE PATRIARCHS IN HEBRON.
